Hello,

Below you will find our tentative trout stream sampling (electrofishing) schedule for this coming June, July and August. Again, this year, you will only need to fill out a short volunteer form at the beginning of any day you come out to sample with us, rather than sending a detailed one ahead of time. We always appreciate the extra hands to help with our sampling, but even if you just want to come to watch, that is fine too.

At the beginning of each month, I will send out a more detailed email with meeting times and locations for each day.

Tentative schedule:

June 21, 22 and 23 - East Koy Creek. This is a survey to evaluate the success of stocking a hybrid strain of brown trout, thus we will be shocking long sections of the stream so we can handle as many fish as possible looking for fin clipped stocked trout.

June 28 and 29 - Flynn Brook (Spring Brook), trib to Cattaraugus Creek.

June 30 - back up day if needed.

July 5 and 6 - Fenton Brook

July 7 - back up day if needed.

July 19, 20 and 21 - Elton Creek.

July 21 and 26 - McKinstry Creek.

July 26 and 27 - Hosmer Brook.

August 2 and 3 - Lime Lake Outlet.

August 4 - back up day if needed.

August 9, 10, 11, 16, 17 and 18 - Wiscoy Creek.

August 23 and 24 - Wiscoy Creek and N. Branch Wiscoy Creek. These will be sites we are sampling to evaluate young-of-year production, although we will be picking up adult trout we encounter as well.

August 25, 29, 30, 31 and September 1 - Back up days if needed.
